

## **The John B. Hawley Memorial Fellowship Notice of Intent to Award Fellowship(s) in 2010**

The Hawley Fellowship was established to promote graduate study and research in hydraulic and sanitary engineering. **The recipient must have an affiliation with the Texas Section-ASCE and with a Texas school at the time of application.** The study should preferably be done in Texas. The stipend is a gift to the recipient, whose obligations are to make the most of the opportunity and to file brief reports with the trustees.

To apply, send a letter of application to the trustee chairman. Include in the letter of application the following;

1. Objectives of program of study and/or research;
2. Description of program;
3. Education background, including grade record;
4. Work experience;
5. Financial requirements to accomplish program and all expected sources of financial support;
6. Two letters of recommendation by persons familiar with the education and professional background of the applicant and his/hers potential to benefit from the program.
